Globes in the Collection

Indo-Persian celestial Globe Inventory No. 98115

Probably an Indo-Persian celestial globe dated 1121 A.H, equivalent to 1709/10 A.D. in the Christian calendar. It is made of brass, with silver 'stars'.

The ecliptic equatorial and other great circles are marked; the constellations are pictorially represented, and various stars are indicated by inlaid silver points each surrounded by a small engraved circle.
